1) Act of Remembrance.

2) Reminds us of the broken body and shed blood of Christ

3) An act of praising and thanksgiving.

I Cor. 11:26 Act of Testimony

I Cor 11: 28, 31 An Act of Examination

I Cor. 10: 16-17 An Act of Communion

1) Communion = Fellowship

Who is it given to: To His N.T. Church

I Cor. 1:2 Church at Corinth

Mark 14:22-26 Given to His Disciples

1) Christ administered to His N.T. Church

I Cor. 11:28 Must be in Fellowship with God

II Cor. 13:5 Examine Self

1) FAITH – A System of Doctrine and Teaching

Rom. 2:2 God's Judgment and His Truth

John 17:17 Thy Word is Truth

John 15:3 Clean through the Word

1) One must examine self according to the Word of God – NOT A FEELING

Matt. 5:23-24 Must be in Fellowship with Man

1) A sign to ALL mankind
