- 1) The Lord separated all other churches by calling it His.
- 2) If Christ called it His, built it, there must be something that set it apart from all others.
- 3) Who else built this church – (God)

Def. Of Church: A Local, visible, called out assembly of Scripturally Baptized believers covenanted together under New Testament Law for the purpose of carrying out the great commission with the Holy Spirit dwelling in their midst with the unbroken lineage to the time of Christ down to today.

Present As A Chaste Virgin

- 1) Paul says he is jealous with Godly jealousy – Why?
- 2) Church espoused, engaged, presented as a chaste virgin to Jesus Christ.

John 3:22-30

He That Hath The Bride Is The Bridegroom

- 1) A difference was made between John's disciples and Christ's disciples.
- 2) Both disciples are saved and scripturally baptized.
- 3) Who is the bride in V.22? – His disciples (Christ).
- 4) Who is the bridegroom? – Jesus Christ.
- 5) Will John the Baptist be in the Bride?

Can Children Of The Bridegroom Fast

- 1) Difference made between John's disciples and Christ.
- 2) What's the difference?
- 3) John the Baptist came to prepare the way for the Lord's N.T. Church.

Matt. 4:17-22

Jesus Established His N.T. Church

- 1) Jesus goes to his prepared material and calls them for a purpose.
- 2) Christ's disciples are referred to as the Bride (John 3:2).

Called, Chosen, Faithful

- 1) Qualification of Bridal relationship
- 2) Must be called – Salvation
- 3) Must be chosen – Scriptural Baptism
- 4) Must be faithful – According to Scriptures

Matt. 20:1-16

Many Are Called But Few Are Faithful

- 1) Every man from the beginning of the N.T. Church has had the opportunity to be saved, Scripturally Baptized, and a Faithful member of a N.T. Church.
- 2) Many may come to N.T. Church, become a member and won't be chosen because they won't give into the teachings and live faithfully for the Lord.

Christ Does The Choosing

- 1) Christ speaking to his N.T. Church calling them friends.
- 2) Nothing is hid from us, all that God expects is found in his Word.
- 3) Only those faithful in a N.T. Church can bring forth fruit.

- 1) Must be found faithful in the little things.
- 2) If found faithful in little things, God will reward with true riches.
- 3) All saved are stewards.
- 4) Faithful must keep all things, not few things.

- 2) Arrayed in fine linen, the righteousness of saints.

New City Jerusalem

- 1) Dwelling place of the Bride (wife) of Christ.
- 2) New City of Jerusalem is not the Bride.

The Lord Adds

- 1) Unless you are scripturally saved you cannot be apart of the Bride.
- 2) Must be added by the Lord.
- 3) Before the Lord can add, must be scripturally baptized.
- 4) Are you willing to take a chance on your Baptism?

Acts 2:41

Must Be Baptized

- 1) Those who gladly receive His word—lost man cannot gladly receive His Word.
- 2) They were Baptized because sin forgiven (V.38) not to forgive sin.

- 1) The woman chosen above all women was Mary.
- 2) Yet to Jesus Christ the ministry was more important.
- 3) How important to you is the ministry of Jesus Christ?

John 14:15

If Ye Love Me

- 1) The Lord said if you love me, you will.
- 2) He didn't say you would do your best.

Matt. 10: 37-38

He That Loveth Anything More Than Me

- 1) Who or what is more important than Jesus Christ?
- 2) Children, wife, hunting, fishing, sports, job, vacation, etc...
- 3) If you have ever missed services for one of these, there more important.
- 4) Does willful sin once in awhile really matter?

Willful Sin

- 1) These scriptures speaking nothing but forsaking the assembly.
- 2) (V.26) When we sin willfully there remains no more sacrifice for sin.
